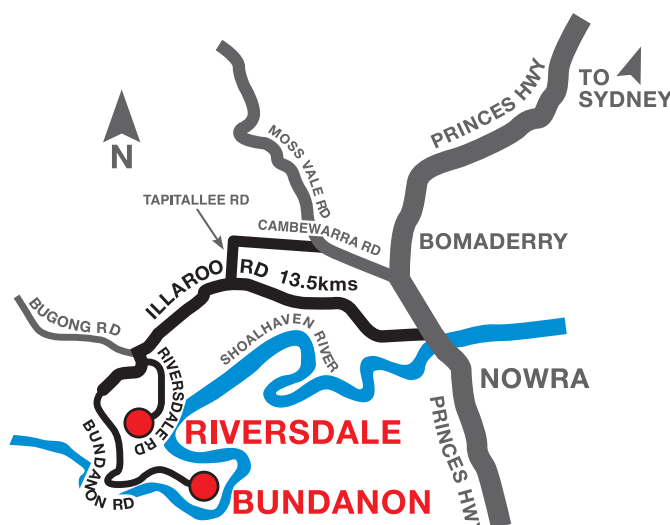
TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS
